

Poster presentation guidelines

- Each poster presenter must bring a printed version of their poster.
- Upload a poster PDF for publication in seminar site on or before 25 th of May. The PDF file size must be less than 10 MB

Poster presentation guidelines

Poster number labels will be provided on site and will be placed above your poster on the board. At least one of the authors must be present at your poster during the entire presentation session and explain their poster (in not more than 5 minutes) to the panel of judges. All posters must be set up in the time allotted before the session, and must remain up until the day ends. Presenters are to remain by their poster during the evaluation by the judges to answer the questions.

Guideline Poster format

Your poster must bring the printed posters in DIN A0 (841mm x 1189mm) or DIN A0 Oversize (882mm x 1247mm), upright format (Portrait). Posters must be organised into sections such as Introduction, Objectives, Materials and Methods, Results and Conclusion. The letter size should be 20mm (font size 80pts) for headings, 15mm (font size 60pts) for author affiliations and subheadings(Introduction, objectives, materials and methods, results and conclusion) and 10mm (font size 40 pts) for body text. The posters should be printed on paper. Jutify the text and the font should be Times New Roman.

Poster presentation will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

- Quality and relevance of the abstract.
- Content and lay out of the poster
